<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All residents and visitors of Deerfield Beach are eligible to use the community bus shuttle transportation – DB Express I &amp; II.</li> <li>• Seniors sixty years old and older who reside in the northeast section of Broward County are eligible for transportation services provided by the Center for Active Aging.</li> <li>• Seniors sixty-two years old and older are eligible for CDBG transportation services.</li> </ul>
